How our logo and statues came to be known as "Ralph"

The spirit of "Ralph" invites us all to live a full, joyful life, willing to try new things and take on life's challenges. The Inspiration for our logo figure and statues was a loveable boy who had a disability few people understood in the 1920s. Most people believed Ralph should be placed in an institution.

Unlike the rest of the world, Alvina Hammer believed Ralph deserved to live in a loving environment, a home setting with a school that would focus on his abilities and desires to express himself. Ralph and his family trusted Alvina and he soon became part of the first Hammer School. Ralph grew into adulthood, living a full and joyful life at Hammer until he passed away in 1995.

Ralph embodies the spirit of Hammer, a community of people who respect the individual's abilities, whose collective spirit makes dreams come true and whose innovations continue to lead the way for people with disabilities.
